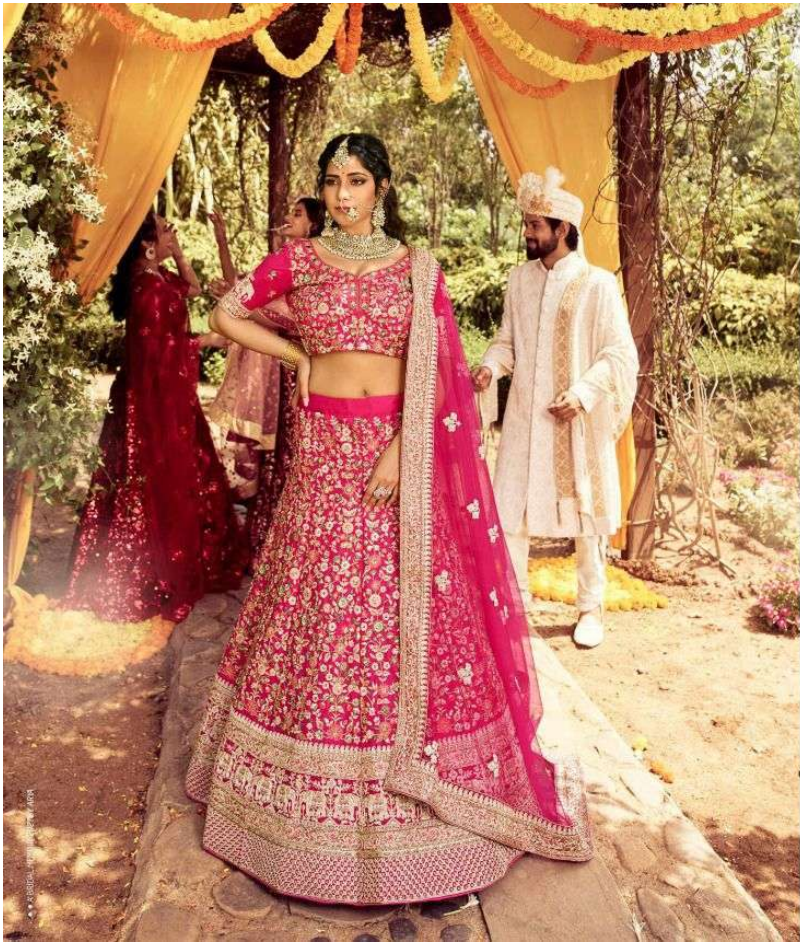

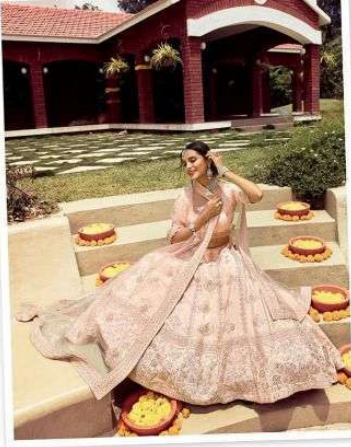

**BRIDE'S CHECKLIST ,**

**What should be on the modern bride's checklist?**  
 Flattering modern silhouettes in traditional textiles looks stunning and apart from red and pinks, fresh hues of green, blue and ivory are a must try.

**What are the bridal myths we would like to bust?**  
 As times evolve, your bridal colour palette isn't restricted to just traditional full-suits options, allow your imagination to run wild and free. The quickest way to reinvent is to employ a unique colour combination. When you think of Indian brides/wed, the first thing that comes to mind is a red ensemble, but that isn't your only choice. Brides can experiment with unconventional hues such as pastels, turquoise, mauve, blue, ivory and green.

**These places are modern heirloom. How do we preserve them for next generations?**  
 The clock starts ticking on the longevity of your bridal threads immediately after the wedding. After the ceremony, it is of utmost importance to have your bridal outfit thoroughly dry-cleaned. Then wrap it in a sack of unbleached cotton cloth or muslin and preferably store the garments in a box made from acid-free materials.

**How can a bride style distinct looks for different wedding events?**  
**Engagement:** begin the festivities with a voluminous anarkali and an ornate dupatta to make heads turn.  
**Mehendi:** Tulle skirts paired with a wrap top or layered with a jacket are an ideal option, given the liveliness of this ceremony.

**Sangeet:** Shine under the spotlight in a bright-hued lehenga skirt paired with an embellished crop top.  
**Cocktail:** Look to an elegantly embroidered ensemble to help you look effortlessly chic.

**Wedding:** A gorgeous lehenga set with intricate work details is an excellent candidate.  
**Reception:** Wind up your nuptials in an ethnic, Indian-inspired bridal ensemble, over the world. And as awareness and education around ethical and sustainable fashion continues to increase.

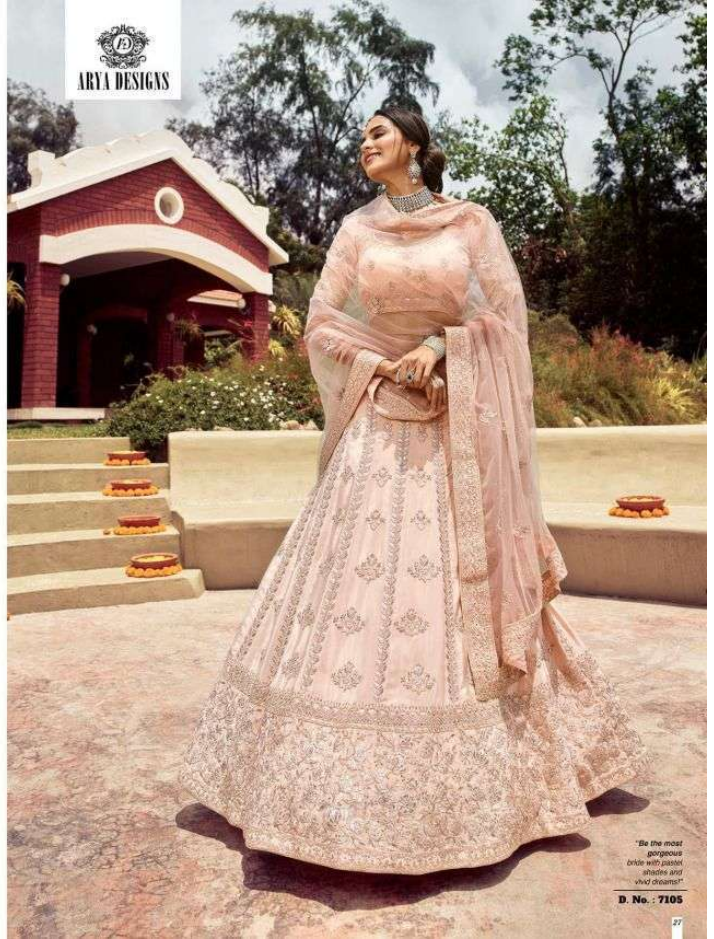
**Intimate wedding:** This setting calls for comfort; a light, embroidered lehenga would be an ideal pick.

Similarly, jackets and bralettes with jeans or lehengas.

**What are the bridal myths we would like to bust?**  
 From sporting unconventional hues to employing overall weightlessness, what was considered typical bridal wear has morphed over the years. Embracing modernity is not the same as forsaking traditions. With some creativity, it's possible to create a beautiful space where contemporary styles and traditional weaves coexist. Monochromes look so elegant and graceful, and are the perfect way for a bride to stand out.
